How will the UBC look in 2023?

Three two-day events run Back-to-Back

This means that there will be three separate events, each lasting two days, and they will be held consecutively or back-to-back.

Teams of three, 3-bowl pairs

Each team will consist of three players. Teams will rotate players and combinations between games. All players must play a minimum number of matches.

Limited to 26 teams

Limited to the first 26 to enter. Priority entrance will be given to previous team owners.

Two Sections per Event

There will be two separate sections in each event.

Reduced entry fees now starting at just \$15,000 AUD

The cost to enter the event has been reduced and ranges from \$15k - \$30k

Options to draft 0-3 players

Teams will have the option to draft anywhere from 0 to 3 players to form their team.

\$280,500 AUD prize pool

There will be a total prize pool of \$280,500 AUD* available for the teams that compete in the Championship.

Discounts for multi-team entries

When entering more than one team you will have access to discounts on preselected players.

Females in sport

We are proud to promote inclusivity and gender equality by encouraging females to take part in the action. In 2023 there will be no cost for preselected female players.

What is included for your team?

Player Accommodation

Accommodation will be provided for players who need it, making it more convenient for them to participate in the Championship.

Lunches and Dinners

Lunch and dinner will be provided for players during the event, ensuring that they are well-fed and energised for their matches.

Player Draft night

There will be a special draft night where teams can select their players, adding to the excitement of the Championship.

Team logo design

Each team will have a unique logo designed for them, adding to the team spirit and camaraderie of the Championship.

Team uniforms and design work

Teams will have customised uniforms, with design work that represents their team and sponosors.

Use of Orange and Blue pool bowls

The event will feature the use of orange and blue bowls, adding a visual element to the matches and making them more engaging for spectators. These are provided for use by the UBC

Player and Team performance statistics

Performance statistics for individual players and teams will be tracked and made available in realtime, adding a competitive element to the event.

Automated, real-time results and standings accessible at the venue and our website

The event will feature an automated system that provides real-time results and standings, making it easy for spectators and players to stay up-to-date on the progress of the event.

TV rink Backboard and A-frame signage logo placement

The event will feature a TV rink backboard and A-frame signage with logo placement, increasing visibility for sponsors. Teams are provided with space to advertise their sponsors.

Live streaming of all six days to UBC Facebook and YouTube pages

The event will be live-streamed for all six days on the UBC Facebook and YouTube pages, allowing viewers from around the world to watch the matches and stay engaged in the event.

Golden Touch and Ultimate Team Awards

There will be special awards given out for the Golden Touch and Ultimate Team, adding an extra element of competition and recognition for outstanding performance.

UBC Website page promotion of team/ club/sponsors

The UBC website will feature a page promoting the teams, clubs, and sponsors involved in the event, increasing visibility and exposure for all involved.


Personalised Team photography packs

We have included a multi-team discount which incentivises participation of teams from the same source through reduced rates. The discount pricing structure provides savings based on the number of participating teams, such as free preselected players for Teams 2 and 3. Overall, the multi-team discount is a smart way to encourage more teams to participate in an event, while also helping team owners to budget and plan for the event with greater certainty.
